Market Steers and Heifer Class Rules:

1. Market steers and heifers will be shown by weight, not by Breed.
2. All entries will be weighed and divided into classes.
3. Heifers/Steers shown in the market show cannot be shown in the breeding classes.

Classes:

1. Lightweight steer or heifer—800 pounds and under
2. Heavyweight steer or heifer—801- pounds and over
3. Champion Class—top market steer/heifer selected from placing animals in classes 1-2.
4. Reserve Champion class—selected from remaining class 3.
